



Confidentiality Policy

Any information regarding your child or your family, given to me either verbally or in writing, will be treated as confidential.

Parents will have access to their own child's records but not to others. All documentation relating to your child is stored securely and not accessible to any other party.

We will not discuss your child with others unless we have permission from you, for example to take your baby to be weighed by the Health Visitor. We will however divulge confidential information to Social Services and to Ofsted if we have any concerns that your child is being abused. Please see my Child Protection Policy.

You will also find out confidential information about our family and us during the course of our working relationship and we would be grateful if you too would respect our family's confidentiality and not repeat what you may have been told to other parties.

This is the basis of a professional and trustful relationship to enable your child to thrive in our care.
